Looking to start a monthly program wherein one parent would come with student to religious education making FAMILY the key.
- B. Pastoral Care: Discussion regarding burying the remains of miscarried babies.
- C. Human Concerns: Giving tree collection scheduled for December 15, 2019.
- D. Prayer and Worship: Planning Advent and Christmas Activities. Blue Christmas mass is scheduled and open to anyone. Reconciliation is scheduled and Friars are willing to help. The anointing mass was well received and worthwhile.
