

## **Religious Education High School Program**

*The Religious Education program is open to students in 9th - 12th grade.*

### **9th - 11th Grade**

Registration costs \$50 per student.

#### **Mass and class:**

The 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month

September - April

6:00 - 8:00 PM

St. Joe's Church and school building

#### **Service and Community event:**

Every student must attend at least one Service and Community event. The options are as follows:

Cristo Rey Ranch - Friday, July 23, 8 AM - 12 PM

St. Joe's Church and School - Sunday, August 22, 7:45 AM - 12 PM

Riverwest Food Pantry Urban Farm (Milwaukee) - Wednesday, October 13, 5 PM - 10 PM

#### **Service:**

Each student in the program is expected to complete at least 5 service hours in addition to the service and community event they attend. Students must fill out service hour reflection forms.

### **Confirmation**

Confirmation is open to 11th and 12th graders.

There is an additional fee of \$50 for the Confirmation retreat.

#### **Confirmation program requirements:**

Confirmation candidates are expected to attend the overnight Confirmation retreat on November 6 - 7, 2021.

Confirmation candidates will choose a Confirmation sponsor and have at least two intentional Confirmation meetings with said sponsor.

Confirmation candidates will serve as a lector or in another capacity at one of the Sunday night Masses at St. Joe.

Confirmation candidates will choose a Confirmation saint and write a short reflection on the saint's life.

Confirmation candidates will fill out a Confirmation questionnaire to be sent to the Bishop.

Confirmation candidates will have a meeting with the Director of Religious Education (Catherine) and Fr. Randy.

Confirmation candidates and their sponsors will be present for Confirmation on May 15, 2022.

### **12th Grade**

There is no cost for 12th graders who would like to continue in religious education.

12th graders who have been confirmed are encouraged to continue attending Mass and class on Sunday evenings. If they so desire, they can assist the adult small group leaders as youth leaders in the small groups.

12th graders are also encouraged to attend Service and Community events, but are not expected to turn in service hour forms.
