Family Faith Formation

Registration is open for families who desire to sign up for religious education. Our Family Faith Formation program is open to the whole family – from infants up to 12th graders and their parents or guardians. See below for more information.

Whole Family Catechesis at a Glance

- Open to all families with children from Pre-K 12th grade.
- We meet on the 2nd Sunday of the month, beginning Sept 8. The April session will be the 1st Sunday of the month (April 6), to avoid Palm Sunday.
- The program runs from September through April.
- Family Formation Families and all families seeking Sacraments must attend one
 of the monthly Adoration/Confession/Mass evenings -- 2nd Wednesday of the
 Month, with extra evenings during Advent/Lent.
- Families are expected to volunteer together for 4 hours OR go on one family pilgrimage, then submit a form summarizing their experience.
- The Sacraments of First Communion and First Reconciliation are available to children in 2nd grade or older. Students must attend a First Communion and First Reconciliation retreat.
- The Sacrament of Confirmation is available to students in 11th grade or older.

 Students must attend additional sessions and a Confirmation retreat.
- Parents and students are expected to attend all sessions, which includes Sunday Mass. Missed sessions must be made up by the family.
- As Catholics, we are all expected to participate in weekly and Holy Day Masses.
